# Day 1 — Surrender & Trust

**Scripture:** Proverbs 3:5 — "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding."

## Day 5 — Wisdom

## Day 6 — Work & Vocation

**Scripture:** Colossians 3:23 — "Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord."

For many, their businesses are not just stores or companies, they are the fabric of their lives and the lives of their loved ones. We pray God that You will guide all business owners and provide for their employees and their families during this difficult and uncertain time.

We pray that every business owner along with their employees and family, will not be overcome by fear and worry, but that each and every one will trust in You and find wisdom and guidance in You. We pray that as they do this, that they will make wise decisions, the decisions that are best that can be made, and that they will make these decisions at precisely the right moments.

God, be with our business owners, their employees, and their families. Bless them and keep them. In Jesus name we pray. Amen.

## Day 8 — Emotional Healing

**Scripture:** Psalm 34:18 — "The Lord is close to the brokenhearted."

**Prayer:** God, I'm coming to You with a heart that feels a little worn out. You already know what's been weighing on me, but I want to lay it before You anyway, because I trust You with the things I don't always know how to carry.

I'm asking You to meet me right here—in the middle of the mess, the confusion, the heaviness. Please calm the parts of me that feel anxious, soothe the places that feel bruised, and remind me that I'm not walking through any of this alone.

Help me release what I've been gripping too tightly. Help me forgive where I need to forgive, let go where I need to let go, and heal where I need healing. Fill the empty spaces with Your peace, the kind that doesn't even make sense sometimes but somehow settles everything inside me.

Thank You for being patient with me, for loving me even when I feel unlovable, and for staying close when I feel distant. Keep guiding me, steadying me, and reminding me that You're restoring me one step at a time.

## Day 9 — Spiritual Growth

**Scripture:** 2 Peter 3:18 — "Grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ."

**Prayer:** Lord Jesus,

Thank You for calling us into a life that grows and deepens over time. As a community, we don't want to stay where we are — we want to grow together in the grace and knowledge of You, our Lord and Savior.

Teach us to receive Your grace with open hands and open hearts. Help us extend that same grace to one another, especially when we stumble or misunderstand each other. Let Your grace shape the way we speak, forgive, encourage, and walk alongside one another.

And Lord, help us grow in the knowledge of who You are. Not just information, but a living, shared relationship with You. Open our eyes to Your presence in our daily lives. Help us recognize Your voice, trust Your character, and follow Your leading as one body.

Thank You for being patient with us as we learn. Thank You for never giving up on our growth — individually and together. Keep forming us into a community that reflects Your love, Your truth, and Your heart for the world.

We want to grow, Jesus — in grace, in knowledge, and in closeness to You.

## Day 10 — Forgiveness

**Scripture:** Ephesians 4:32 — "Be kind and compassionate... forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you."

**Prayer:** God of mercy, hear us as we confess our sins.  
For the thing that made us slow to learn from Christ,  
Reluctant to follow him,  
And afraid to bear the cross:  
Lord have mercy, **Lord, forgive**

For the sin that is caused the poverty of our worship,  
The formality and selfishness of our prayers,  
Our neglected worship and the means of grace,  
And our hesitating witness for Christ:  
Lord have mercy, **Lord forgive.**

For the sin that has lead us to misuse your gifts,  
Evade our responsibilities  
And fail to be good stewards of your creation:  
Lord have mercy, **Lord forgive**

For the sin that has made us unwilling to overcome evil with good,  
Tolerant of injustice,  
Quick to condemn,  
And selfish in sharing your love with others:  
Lord have mercy, **Lord forgive.**

Have mercy on us our God,  
In your constant love;  
In the fullness of your mercy;

Blot out our offences.  
Wash away all our guilt,  
And cleanse us from our sin.  
Create in us a new heart, oh God.  
Renew a right spirit within us.  
Give us the joy of your help again and strengthen us with a  
willing spirit.

If we confess our sins,

## Day 11 — Friends & Community

**Scripture:** Proverbs 17:17 — "A friend loves at all times."

**Prayer:** Hey God,

You know how much I need them, even when I pretend I don't. Help me be the kind of friend who listens well, laughs easily, and shows up when it matters. Teach me to be patient when things get messy, forgiving when someone slips up, and honest in a way that builds, not breaks.

Bless the friends I have — the close ones, the new ones, the ones I haven't talked to in a while but still care about. Keep them safe, give them peace, and remind them they're loved. And if there are people I'm meant to grow closer to, open that door. If there are friendships that need healing, guide me in that too.

Thank you for the gift of connection, for the people who make life feel less heavy and more hopeful.

## Day 12 — Emergency Services

**Scripture:** Psalm 91:11 — "For He will command His angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways."

**Prayer:** Rescuing God,

Thank you for the people who stand ready when the rest of us are afraid or unsure.

Bless every part of our emergency services — each one carrying a different responsibility, but all united by courage and compassion.

For our ambulance crews, who step into chaos with calm hands and steady hearts, give them clarity, resilience, and moments of peace in the middle of pressure.

For our firefighters, who face heat, smoke, and danger to protect lives and homes, strengthen their bodies and guard their spirits.

For our police officers, who walk into uncertainty every day, grant them wisdom, fairness, and safety as they serve their communities.

For our Coast Guard, watching over our shores and responding to emergencies at sea, keep them alert, protected, and supported as they face unpredictable waters.

For the RNLI, launching into storms and darkness to rescue those in peril, steady their boats, guide their decisions, and bring them home safely after every shout.

For Mountain Rescue, climbing into cold winds, steep paths, and hidden valleys to find the lost and the injured, give them sure footing, sharp instincts, and protection in every search.

For all who volunteer, all who train, all who respond without  
hesitation — surround them with strength.

Bless their families, who wait and worry.

Comfort those who've seen too much.

Restore those who are tired.

And remind them that their service matters more than they may  
ever know.

## Day 13 — Physical Health

**Scripture:** Isaiah 40:29 — "He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak."

**Prayer:** Gracious God,

You know our bodies better than we ever could. You see the places that feel tired, the parts that are weak, and the habits that don't always serve us well. We come to You honestly, asking for Your strengthening touch.

Breathe fresh life into us. Restore what has been worn down. Steady what feels unsteady. Shape our desires so that the choices we make—what we eat, how we rest, how we move—reflect the truth that our bodies are Your temple, a dwelling place for Your Holy Spirit.

Help us to honour You not just with our words, but with the way we care for the bodies You've entrusted to us. Give us wisdom in our routines, discipline in our habits, and grace for the days when we fall short.

Thank You for being patient with us, for walking with us, and for offering strength that goes beyond our own. Make us whole in body, mind, and spirit, so that our lives point back to You.

# Day 14 — The Nation

**Scripture:** Psalm 33:12 — "Blessed is the nation whose God is the Lord."

**Prayer:** Gracious God, Eternal King  
we come to You with our country on our hearts.

Thank You for the good that still grows here, for the people who show up for one another, often quietly, often without applause. We ask that You keep shaping us into a nation that remembers compassion is a strength, not a weakness.

Prince of peace, please give wisdom to our leaders. Clear their minds when noise and pride crowd in. Help them listen more than they speak, seek truth over power, and choose what is right even when it costs them something. Let their decisions be guided by humility, courage, and care for the whole, not just the loudest voices.

We especially ask You to draw close to the most vulnerable among us. Those who are struggling to get by, those who feel forgotten, those who carry fear, hunger, illness, or loneliness. Surround them with support, dignity, and hope. And where support is missing, stir our hearts to step in.

Heal what is divided. Soften what has grown hard. Teach us how to disagree without losing our humanity, how to serve without expecting credit, how to love our neighbors in real and practical ways.

Forgive us, Lord, for the ways we have failed to love You and one another. Teach us to walk in humility, to repent quickly, and to live boldly as followers of Christ. May our country be a

place where Your light shines in the darkness and where the name of Jesus is honored.

We ask all of this in the saving name of Jesus Christ, our Lord and Savior.

# Day 15 — The Poor & Vulnerable

**Scripture:** Proverbs 19:17 — "Whoever is kind to the poor lends to the Lord."

**Prayer:** Loving God,

You see every person who feels the weight of financial pressure today. You know the stories behind every worry, every bill, every quiet moment of fear. And you care deeply for those who are vulnerable. Thank you for reminding us in Scripture that kindness to the poor is seen and honoured by you — that when we lift up those who struggle, we are lending to your own heart.

So we ask for your protection over those who feel stretched thin or who have nothing. Guard them from despair. Shield them from exploitation. Surround them with people who will treat them with dignity, compassion, and fairness.

Provide what they need, Lord — not just enough to scrape by and survive, but enough to breathe again. Enough to hope again. Enough to feel secure. Open doors to stable work, safe housing, and supportive communities. Let unexpected kindness find them. Let burdens lighten. Let peace settle where anxiety has been living for too long.

And for those of us who have the ability to help, soften our hearts. Make us generous in spirit and practical in action. Teach us to see others the way you see them — precious, beloved, worth showing up for.

Hold every vulnerable person close today, Father. Let them know they are not forgotten, not alone, and never beyond your care.

# Day 16 — Marriage

**Scripture:** 1 Corinthians 13:7 — "Love always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres."

**Prayer:** Gracious God,

You are the One who binds us together in love, and today we lift before you every marriage — those newly formed, those long established, and those quietly carrying burdens that few ever see. You know the joys couples celebrate and the pressures they navigate. You understand the unspoken worries, the tiredness, the longing to stay connected even when life feels busy or strained.

So we ask you, Lord, strengthen marriages with your grace. Let your kindness soften hard edges. Let your mercy heal old wounds. Let your Spirit breathe patience into moments of frustration and tenderness into places that feel fragile.

Fill homes with joy — not just the big, celebratory kind, but the everyday joy that comes from shared laughter, small acts of care, and the steady comfort of knowing someone is truly with you. Restore joy where it has faded. Protect joy where it is flourishing.

Teach couples to reflect your covenant love — faithful, forgiving, resilient, and generous. Help them choose understanding over defensiveness, listening over reacting, unity over pride. When disagreements come, guide them toward peace. When challenges arise, remind them they are on the same team. When they feel stretched thin, hold them close and renew their strength.

Bless those who feel lonely within their marriage. Bless those who are rebuilding trust. Bless those who are celebrating seasons of deep closeness. And bless those who long for hope again. Surround each couple with your wisdom, your protection, and your steadying hand.

May every marriage become a small reflection of your great love — a place where grace is practiced, forgiveness is offered, and joy is shared.

# Day 17 — Children & Youth

**Scripture:** Proverbs 22:6 — "Start children off on the way they should go..."

**Prayer:** Loving God,

We bring before you all our children and young people.

You know each one by name, you see their hearts, and you understand their worries, their dreams, and the things they don't always know how to say. Surround them with your peace when life feels overwhelming. Give them courage when they face challenges, and remind them that they never walk alone. Fill their minds with wisdom, their hearts with kindness, and their days with moments of joy that lift their spirits.

Bless their friendships — help them find people who encourage them, include them, and help them grow. Guide their families, teachers, and all who care for them, giving patience, strength, and compassion.

For those who feel anxious, bring calm. For those who feel lonely, bring comfort. For those who feel unsure of who they are, remind them they are wonderfully made and deeply loved.

Help them discover the gifts you've placed within them, and give them confidence to use those gifts to make the world brighter. Keep them safe, keep them hopeful, and keep them close to you.

## Day 18 — Mission & Evangelism

**Scripture:** Matthew 28:19 — "Go and make disciples of all nations."

**Prayer:** Holy Spirit,

Thank you for being with me in every moment — in the quiet, in the busy, and in the places where I'm not always sure what to do. You know my heart, and you know the people around me who need to experience Your love.

Give me courage when I feel hesitant.

Give me words when I feel unsure.

Give me boldness that's gentle, kind, and full of Your wisdom.

Let my life speak even when my mouth is quiet.

Let my words speak of your grace.

Let my actions reflect Your kindness.

Let my choices point to Your goodness.

Shape me into someone who carries Your love naturally — in the way I listen, the way I serve, the way I forgive, and the way I show compassion. Help me to notice the moments when You're nudging me to step forward, to encourage someone, or to share hope.

Holy Spirit, fill me again. Make my life a testimony of Your grace — not because I'm perfect, but because You are faithful.

## Day 19 — Rest & Sabbath

**Scripture:** Exodus 33:14 — "My presence will go with you, and I will give you rest."

**Prayer:** Sabbath God,

Teach us how to rest in You. In a world that pulls us in every direction, help us find the quiet places where Your peace can reach us. Slow our racing thoughts, soften the tension we carry, and remind us that we don't have to hold everything together on our own.

Restore us mentally with clarity and calm.  
Restore us physically with strength and stillness.  
Restore us emotionally with comfort and hope.  
Restore us spiritually with a fresh awareness of Your presence.

When we forget to pause, draw us back.  
When we try to manage life in our own strength, gently lead us to Your grace.  
When we feel worn out, breathe new life into us.

Teach us to rest not just as a moment, but as a way of living — trusting that You are God, and we are held.

## Day 20 — Financial Stewardship

**Scripture:** Luke 16:10 — "Whoever can be trusted with very little can also be trusted with much."

**Prayer:** Generous God,

Everything we have comes from Your hand. You know our needs, our responsibilities, and the pressures we carry.

Teach us to handle the resources You've entrusted to us with wisdom and care. Guide our decisions so that we use money in ways that honour You. Help us to be thoughtful, not wasteful; grateful, not anxious; generous, not fearful. Show us how to balance what we need with what we can share, and help us recognise the difference. Keep us mindful that every good gift — big or small — is a sign of Your faithfulness. Shape our hearts so that we trust You more than we trust our bank balance.

And when we feel uncertain, remind us that You are our provider, our security, and our source of hope. Lead us in wise stewardship, so that our lives reflect Your goodness and our choices bring blessing to others.

## Day 21 — Creativity & Calling

**Scripture:** Ephesians 2:10 — "For we are God's handiwork... created to do good works."

**Prayer:** Creator, Loving God,

Thank you for the creative gifts you've planted in each of us — the ideas, the imagination, the spark that makes us want to make, build, write, sing, design, or dream. Sometimes we forget those gifts are from you, and sometimes we don't even realise what you've placed inside us. But today we just want to say thank you.

Awaken the creativity that's lying quiet in us. Stir up the gifts we haven't used in a while, and shine a light on the ones we haven't discovered yet. Give us the courage to try, the patience to practise, and the joy that comes from creating something that reflects your goodness.

Help us use our creativity for your glory — not to impress, but to bless. Let what we make bring hope, beauty, encouragement, and kindness into the world. And may our creativity always point back to you, the One who created us in love.

## Day 22 — Protection

**Scripture:** Psalm 121:7 — "The Lord will keep you from all harm."

**Prayer:** Holy One, Keeper of Israel,

We come before You with humble hearts, trusting in Your everlasting faithfulness. You are the God who has watched over Your people through deserts and exile, through joy and celebration, through every generation that has lifted its eyes to the hills and found help in You alone.

You are our Guardian, our Protector, the One who stands beside us in daylight and in darkness.  
Spread Your sheltering wings over us and over those we love.  
Guard our steps as we go out and as we return home.  
Hold us steady when the road feels uncertain, and surround us with Your peace when fear whispers at the edges of our minds.

We cling to the promise of Psalm 121:7 — "The Lord will keep you from all harm; He will watch over your life." Let these words settle deep within us, reminding us that Your protection is not distant or fragile, but strong, constant, and full of compassion. Protect our bodies from danger, our minds from anxiety, our spirits from despair, and our homes from anything that would disturb Your shalom.

Watch over us as You have watched over Your people since ancient days, with steadfast love and unfailing care.

## Day 23 — Joy

**Scripture:** Nehemiah 8:10 — "The joy of the Lord is your strength."

**Prayer:** Rejoicing God,

Fill my heart with Your joy — not the kind that fades when life gets busy or hard, but a joy that stays steady through every season. Let Your joy take root deep within me, so it isn't shaken by circumstances, opinions, or the ups and downs of my own emotions.

When I feel tired, let Your joy be my strength.

When I feel uncertain, let Your joy be my anchor.

When I feel overwhelmed, let Your joy lift my eyes back to You.

Teach me to recognise the small gifts You scatter through my days — the moments of kindness, the glimpses of beauty, the reminders that You are near. Help me to slow down enough to notice them, to receive them, and to let them shape my heart. Let Your joy soften the places in me that feel heavy. Let it brighten the places that feel dim. Let it overflow into my words, my actions, and the way I treat others, so that people around me sense something of Your goodness.

God, fill me again with Your joy — a joy that is steady, deep, and rooted in who You are.

Amen.

## Day 24 — The Elderly

**Scripture:** Isaiah 46:4 — "Even to your old age and gray hairs I am He... I will sustain you."

**Prayer:** Faithful God,

Thank You for the promise You speak over us in Isaiah 46:4 — that You are the One who has carried us from our earliest days, the One who will carry us still, even to our old age and grey hairs.

Your faithfulness does not fade. Your strength does not weaken. Your love does not grow tired. Carry us today in the places where we feel worn out or unsure. Lift the burdens we've been holding for too long. Remind us that we don't have to manage everything in our own strength, because You are the God who sustains, who supports, who holds us steady.

When we feel anxious, be our peace. When we feel fragile, be our refuge. When we feel overwhelmed, be the One who carries us close to Your heart. Teach us to trust the God who has been with us from the beginning and will be with us to the end.

Help us rest in the truth that You will continue to carry, rescue, and uphold us — just as You promised.

Amen.

## Day 25 — The Grieving

**Scripture:** Matthew 5:4 — "Blessed are those who mourn, for they will be comforted."

**Prayer:** Heavenly Father,

Draw near to the broken-hearted. Hold close those whose pain feels too heavy to carry, whose tears come without warning, whose days feel long and whose nights feel even longer. Wrap them in Your gentleness, and let them sense—even in the smallest ways—that they are not alone. Bring peace where there is turmoil, where memories ache and questions linger.

Let Your calm settle over anxious minds and weary bodies. Speak into the silence with the quiet assurance that You are present, steady, and faithful. Bring hope to those who feel lost in their grief. Lift their eyes toward the promise that sorrow does not have the final word. Plant within them the faint but growing light of Your comfort, a reminder that healing is possible, even if it comes slowly. Bring healing to hearts that feel shattered.

Mend what has been broken, restore what has been wounded, and breathe new strength into those who feel they have none left. Surround them with people who will listen, care, and walk gently beside them. Father, draw near to the broken-hearted.

## Day 26 — The Global Church

**Scripture:** John 17:21 — "That all of them may be one..."

**Prayer:** Lord Jesus,

You prayed that "all of them may be one... so that the world may believe" (John 17:21), and today we echo Your prayer with longing and hope.

Unite Your Church across nations, cultures, languages, and traditions. Draw us together not by uniformity, but by love — the love You poured out for the whole world. Break down the walls we have built through misunderstanding, pride, or fear. Heal the wounds caused by division, and soften our hearts where they have grown defensive or suspicious. Teach us to see one another as brothers and sisters, not rivals; as fellow servants, not competitors.

Strengthen the bonds between churches that worship differently, speak differently, or organise themselves differently, yet confess the same Lord. Help us celebrate the richness of our diversity while standing firm in the unity of Your Spirit. Make us one in purpose — to proclaim Your gospel, to serve the poor, to seek justice, to love mercy, and to walk humbly with You. Let our unity be a living testimony to Your grace, a light that draws the world toward Your truth.

Lord Jesus, make us one, just as You and the Father are one.

## Day 27 — Humility

**Scripture:** Philippians 2:3 — "Do nothing out of selfish ambition... rather, in humility value others above yourselves."

**Prayer:** Lord Jesus,

Teach us the way of humility — the way You lived, the way You loved, the way You served.

Your Word in Philippians calls us to do nothing out of selfish ambition or pride, but to value others above ourselves, to look not only to our own interests but to the interests of those around us. We confess that this does not come naturally.

Soften our hearts and shape our character until humility becomes our instinct, not our effort. Help us to walk gently, speak kindly, and act selflessly. Give us the courage to let go of the need to be first, to be right, or to be noticed. Free us from comparison, competition, and the quiet pride that hides in our thoughts.

Lord Jesus, You humbled Yourself, taking the form of a servant, choosing obedience even to the cross. Let that same mindset be alive in us. May our lives reflect Your character, our choices reflect Your love, and our attitudes reflect Your grace.

Make us more aware of the people You place in our path — their needs, their burdens, their stories — and help us respond with compassion. Shape us into people who lift others up, who build others up, and who point others to You.

## Day 28 — Hope

**Scripture:** Romans 15:13 — "May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in Him."

**Prayer:** God of hope,

Fill us today with the hope that only You can give — a hope that doesn't depend on circumstances, emotions, or our own strength, but on Your unchanging goodness.

Let Your hope rise within us like light breaking through the clouds, steady and sure. Pour Your joy into our hearts, even in the places that feel weary or uncertain. Let Your peace settle over our minds, calming every anxious thought and reminding us that we are held by You.

May Your Holy Spirit fill us so completely that hope overflows from our lives into the lives of others. Teach us to trust You more deeply, to lean on Your promises, and to walk forward with confidence in the God who never fails. Let our hope be a witness — a quiet, steady testimony that You are faithful, You are near, and You are at work in all things.

God of hope, fill us with all joy and peace as we trust in You, so that we may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.

## Day 29 — Purpose

**Scripture:** Jeremiah 29:11 — "For I know the plans I have for you..."

**Prayer:** Faithful God,

Thank You for the promise You speak over us in Jeremiah 29:11 — that You know the plans You have for us, plans for peace and not for harm, plans to give us hope and a future. Let those words settle deeply into our hearts today.

Let Your Spirit move among us with grace and power, drawing us back to the heart of worship and the beauty of holiness. And revive our communities, our families, our nation — that Your goodness may be seen, Your mercy known, and Your love experienced by all who long for hope.

Will You revive us again, so that Your people may rejoice in You Lord?
